

Tools and tips for creating a successful survey experience

Introduce yourself – do not get into your life story. (Education staff vs. 'I work here')

Start General – Move Towards Specifics. If you start with specifics, they will focus on that one aspect instead of the entire experience. Also warms them up to the survey.

Be respectful of their time – keep it simple, short, to the point. Get the information you need.

Own it - be confident. Practice prior if you need to.

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Be ready to get what you asked for.
