August 26-Current: Additional Support Activities due to Hurricane Dorian: The National Weather Service has been providing a wide range of Impact-Based Decision Support Services (IDSS) due to Hurricane Dorian. This includes briefings from the National Hurricane Center for national, regional, and state partners. The National Hurricane Center has also been organizing media pools with a wide range of customers. Numerous Southern Region Weather Forecast Offices are in contact with local emergency managers and media. Additional agencies including FEMA and USGS have been briefed. The Aviation Weather Center is also providing twice a day TELCONS to aviation partners. Additional upper air balloon launches are being used to provide more information for forecasters and numerical weather prediction models.
