SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority from the Assistant Administrator for

Fisheries to Regional Directors of the National Marine Fisheries

Service

TO: Regional Directors, Office of National Marine Fisheries Service

- 1. Introduction NOAA Directives Manual 05-60 delegates to the Assistant Administrator for Fisheries authority to approve, disapprove, partially disapprove, or issue fishery management plans (FMPs) and amendments under Sections 304 and 305 of the Magnuson Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1854 and 1855). The Assistant Administrator may redelegate this authority by publication of a NOAA Circular, with the approval of the Administrator.
- 2. Delegation to the Regional Directors The Assistant Administrator for Fisheries delegates the authority to approve, disapprove, or partially disapprove, FMPs and amendments to the appropriate Regional Director of the National Marine Fisheries Service. Where an FMP covers more than one Region, the Assistant Administrator will identify the appropriate Regional Director in writing to the Regional Directors and Regional Fishery Management Councils involved. Authority to issue FMPs will be retained by the Assistant Administrator.
- 3. Redelegation of Authority A Regional Director may redelegate the authority to approve, disapprove, or partially disapprove an FMP or amendment only to the Deputy Regional Director.
- 4. Reservation of Authority The Administrator and the Assistant Administrator reserve the authority to be advised before final action is taken to approve, disapprove, partially disapprove, or issue an FMP or amendment. Under Section 3(d) of NOAA Directives Manual 05-60, the Secretary must be advised in particular instances (generally where the FMP has proved controversial) before final action is taken.

5. Effect on Other Instructions - NOAA Circular 83-6 filed with NDM 05-60 is hereby superseded.
