How dispute started: The National Weather Service director said Monday that its Birmingham office acted to shut down rumors before discovering that the president had started them. Opposite sides: National Weather Service director Louis Uccellini said forecasters in Birmingham did the right thing and that was only later that they found out the source of the mistaken information, he said - and that it was Donald Trump. Earlier, the president of the 2,100-member association, **Paul Schlatter**, said any forecast office 'would have done the exact same thing' as the Birmingham forecast office.
