I was hoping you or someone at NWS could clarify what exactly the NHC was predicting on September 1 and 2 with regards to Hurricane Dorian hitting Alabama.

In a statement yesterday, Homeland Security and Counterterrorism Advisor Rear Admiral Peter Brown said: "From the evening of Tuesday, August 27, until the morning of Monday, September 2, forecasts from the National Hurricane Center (NHC) showed possibility of tropical storm force winds hitting parts of Alabama."

Would you be able to provide me with the data illustrating the admiral's assertion? This is an issue the White House does not deal with unfortunately.
