I doubt ICF can do the SSS (stream salmonid simulator) modeling but USGS or USFWS can. BOR can give one of these entities funds to perform the model runs. ICF may be able to do the SONCC coho salmon habitat modeling, but there are also entities at USFWS and BOR (TRRP) who could do that.
