Hi Robert,

Reclamation recently informed us that they will not be seeking consultation on any of the effects of the Trinity River Division on NMFS jurisdictional species (Coho, Eulachon, Orca, Green Sturgeon) in the Trinity River or the Klamath River. They will be looking at TRD effects to Sacramento species (winter-run Chinook, etc), however not the species on this side of the hill.
