I discovered this afternoon that the Critical Habitat table in the Steelhead I&S section is missing most of the Stanislaus and San Joaquin River division rows (just has a row related to dissolved oxygen). The full sets of rows for each Critical Habitat table (one for Stan, one for SJR) are attached.

Please do a quick review of these tables by Friday morning (say, 10am?). The plan is to drop in these rows to the current CH tables (tomorrow morning?) prior to sharing for DOI/Reclamation and peer review.

I made the same oversight in the spring-run I&S section; will send the SR tables in a separate e-mail.

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
