If Reclamation has the data I'll look at it, but I don't think that the proposed project will impact water temperature in the Delta is as much as it will in the tributaries and tailwaters below dams. Ambient water temperatures in the Delta will more than likely have more to do with current tidal and wind mixing as well as air temperatures than project actions. By the time water reaches the Delta it has had a long time to equilibrate with ambient conditions, so that effects of the Project are secondary to ambient conditions.
