As a reminder, the new column is:

Description of the Proposed Action: Is there information or science that supports the proposed action or components of the proposed action? Has the proposed action provided the science to support its description? For example, is there recent information or science to support the proposed Shasta Summer Cold Water Temperature Management; proposed changes to OMR, removing I:E, HORB or Georgiana Slough Barriers from the Proposed Action. Think back to our "gap" analysis review of the draft proposed action during the tiger team meetings.
