During Friday's ROC on LTO BA sufficiency review meeting, you said that you miss Bruce because he was the lead for Clifton Court Forebay (CCF). I was very surprised to hear that. Over the past year and 4 months since Bruce retired, there has been a gap in lead staff coverage for CCF and its RPA implementation, but there hasn't been a gap in coverage. You should've seen in my end of week WODC Branch Chief updates the various official correspondence associated with CCF predation reduction, which are also in the "Other Electronic Documents" folder, and if you missed them, that geographic area is still within WODC Branch jurisdiction, so you could've/should've just asked me.

I'll (try to) put together the quarterly meeting notes and associated documentation in the WODC Branch folder on the server soon, and if you don't see anything there, please remind me or check with me on its status.
