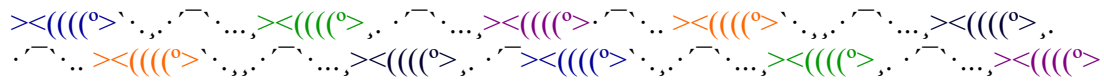
Hi All -
