--**Stanislaus:** 50 acres of rearing habitat changed from "15 acres of site-specific and 16-50 not reasonably certain to occur" to "effects of up to 50 acres considered at framework level and any restoration projects that fall within the CV programmatic BiOp are covered at site-specific level"

--**SJR:** Lower SJR Rearing habitat changed from "not reasonably certain to occur" to "framework level".
