Almost done -- here is the sneak preview for your meeting. When I send the doc, I think you could go through at the meeting together if you wanted; all my comments are drafted in the expectation that would be shared with Reclamation.

Addressed most edits -- even if I didn't accept DOI wording; I tried to capture the spirit of the suggested edit in my own words. However, the key flags for DOI are that NMFS did not accept the proposed deletion of the Perry Survival Modeling and Buchanan results. NMFS *did* accept the proposed caveat in the introduction to the Perry Survival Modeling (to acknowledge that the real-time triggers might offer better protection than shown in the modeling), and added some context to the section discussing the Buchanan model. Another flag is that while NMFS accepted deletions related to COS/RPA in the "Deconstruction of the Action" sections, NMFS retained, for comparative purposes, some discussion of the COS when evaluating effects of the PA. I did remove "RPA" from any flagged sections.

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
