Subject: Elevation issues for Trinity River Divison/CVP

Hi all,

CCO and CVO representatives had a follow up call this morning with Reclamation and other agencies to discuss our comments on the Proposed Action sections of the Trinity River Division that were presented on Wednesday's ROC Tiger Team meeting. The meeting went as well as it could, and we collaboratively learned from each other's perspectives and identified operational and process constraints. Overall, Reclamation needed to caucus internally on many topics to decide whether they would incorporate our suggestions into the proposed action. One major fundamental concern is that Reclamation may be leaning towards excluding the Trinity River Division (TRD) from the consultation (or at least the BA). We feel that the TRD is part of the CVP and therefore is part of the proposed action.

Attached is a [Google table](#) summarizing the key issues, Reclamation's perspective, potential path forward, and our recommendations on whether these issues need elevation. Please note that many of these topics do need elevation if Reclamation doesn't address our concerns.
