2. Workflow for next week:

- Tues 5/28, **5 pm**: All effects sections complete in order to be used by I&S leads on next day and sent to ARA, GC, RegSec7. Excerpted pieces of Delta, Shasta, and WOA to Reclamation (Barb, Cathy, Howard, Brittany assist).
