Did my additional bullet of operations during the filling period make it into the draft reinitiation triggers? If so, we might want to let USFWS know, in case they agree or want to be consistent. Filling an additional 600 TAF may have operational changes that are not considered in the Shasta ops, like tempering flows and reducing floodplain access (or duration).
