John -- Thanks for helping us out on this. Attached are my edits to your SRKW prey analysis (and an associated workbook, FYI). **Are you able to turn around the next revision by COB Wednesday, May 1?** I'd also like to get your workbook(s) with your data tables (and formulas) for our admin record; that will be a helpful way to be sure we have all calculations in our record. The timeline on that has more leeway; say by mid-May.

Edits overview: A lot are stylistic to sync up with our naming conventions, the more substantive are generally to try to (in inline edits) or to ask you to (in comments) clarify your calculations. I also added a data summary to the salvage density discussion per Dan's suggestion. You can ignore the "for CCVO follow-up" edits; I'll look into those and check back with you if we want to change anything on those topics.
