Megan Bryant is reviewing the scope for the LCM agreement and wants to scrub out the NMFS stuff - she says that:

- 1) As the PI, you must be included in the budget, even if it is as 0%
- 2) As the PI for UCSC, you cannot also be in-kind from NMFS
- 3) If you include in-kind costs from NMFS, you must track them. Alternatively, you can remove reference to in-kind, scrubbing the NMFS items.
- 4) The scope must say UCSC shall... rather than NMFS shall, as this agreement is with UCSC.

I've gone through your document and suggested what might make sense to change - what do you think?
