Please take a look at the critical habitat section first, and maybe the end of the effects to the species. There are a bunch of placeholder bullets, thoughts, etc., that need to be completed.

Let me/us know if you need help with any aspect of the analysis/my comments, and we'll see what we can do.

I added "Clear Creek" to the file name, and think that we should do that, in general. I know that Clear Creek is part of the Trinity River Division, but Reclamation said the are not consulting on the Trinity, so it's a bit confusing when we're looking for Clear Creek documents within our own files.
