I want to make sure we aren't burying the benefits of pulse flows (the analysis mostly focuses on the potential impacts), so I provided some suggested text there. I had similar (the same) comments/edits in the CC effects.

IMO - if we focus on the impacts of actions we have negotiated for them to include, we run the risk of them not doing them! If they are better than nothing, but not good enough, or could be better, we can characterize them that way.
